It's a light creamy sparkling rose offering notes of light orange blossoms, white peach, and fresh strawberry. This is springtime delight in a glass!	119
Chardonnay	Jordan	Russian River Valley, CA 2021	One of the most balanced Jordan Chardonnays to date. Flavors of juicy citrus, Asian pear and lemon peel balance seamlessly with the subtle French oak notes. The cooler-climate vineyard sourcing this year brings even more lively acidity and purity of fruit on the palate—making this vintage especially food-friendly and cellar-worthy.	79
Pinot Noir	Failla	Willamette Valley, OR 2019	#51 Wine Enthusiast Top 100 of 2020 - Lean, elegant, aromatic and filled with mouthwatering natural acidity and taut tannins bound together with fresh herb aromas and brambly fruit on the palate. You'll have to search far and wide to find a Willamette Valley Pinot this good at this price. Winemaker Ehren Jordan is a proven Pinot master, and works his magic here, using fruit from top Chehalem Mountain and Eola-Amity sites. The ripe and focused tannins add notes of espresso and toasted hazelnuts; the wine is a sheer joy to drink. — WS 93 pts	79
Tempranillo	CVNE 'Imperial' Gran Reserva	Rioja, Spain	CVNE's Imperial wines are made from a small plot of their best vines in Rioja Alta and only produced in the very best vintages. "This dark garnet wine has aromas of dark plum, milk chocolate and sage. Flavors of blackberry, black currant, dark chocolate, anisette, oregano and thyme are set into opulent tannins that drop off to reveal a bright finish." WE 95pts	103
Red Blend	Hourglass 'HG111'	Napa Valley, CA 2019	HG III is Tony Biagi's riff on the Napa Valley red blend. Crafted with select lots from our BlueLine Estate and carefully sourced vineyards in Napa Valley, HG III embodies the deft balance of richness and vibrancy that is at the heart of what we do at Hourglass. Merlot offers sleek, approachable texture and bright red fruit components, Petite Sirah provides the anchoring bass notes of dark blue and black fruit, and Cabernet weaves these together with structural framing.	79
Red Blend	Cain 'NV17'	Napa Valley, CA	The Cain NV17 is the ripest, roundest, fullest wine in our collection. The blend of 2016 & 2017 is a wine of wonderful ripeness, that epitomizes our ideals of Cabernet Sauvignon grown in the classic style of the Napa Valley. It displays the aromatic complexity, smooth entry, balanced mouthfeel and graceful finish, which are the signatures of the Cain style.	79
Cabernet Shiraz	Penfolds 'Bin 389'	Magill, Australia 2019	The wine that helped forge Penfolds reputation in the red wine world. By combining the structure of cabernet sauvignon with the richness of shiraz we are left with a balance of fruit and oak like no other. Starting with a bright crimson red color, and then an aroma of port-wine jelly, subtle matchstick, vanilla, and nuttiness this blend is destined to please. Notes of dark fruits and a subtle earthiness are complemented by an understated of oak and tannis.	119
Cabernet Sauvignon	Neyers	Napa Valley, CA 2018	Neyer's Cabernet Sauvignon Red Wine has a bright ruby hue with aromas of wild cherries, chocolate and fresh tobacco leaf. The finished wine is remarkable for its flavor and complexity, and the wine looks to be one that will improve for many years. Planted in 1992 by David Abreu, this fruit is located on ground higher than 600 feet on rocky land rich with basalt. This vineyard is one of the rare 10% in Napa Valley capable of producing great Cabernet Sauvignon. — JS 91 pts	119
Cabernet Sauvignon	Jordan	Alexander Valley, CA 2018	A wine with elegance, refinement, and plenty of verve. Its perfume of blackberries and black cherries mingles with a backdrop of subtle oak notes. The palate has a velvety richness that coats the mouth in concentrated flavors of blackberries and cassis, laced with fine tannins from seamlessly integrated, new French oak. Enticing flavors of chocolate, violets and dark fruits linger on the long finish. — WE 91 pts	135
